46 days or MORE prior to the check-in date: the \$300 security deposit and \$1,200 of the rent payment will be refunded.

45-31 days preceding the check-in date, the student will lose the security deposit (\$300) but will be refunded the \$1,200 of the rent payment.

30-11 days preceding the check-in date, the student is liable for the \$300 security deposit and \$1,200 of the rent payment.

LDM Tuition Cancellation Policy (If an official cancellation notice is received by LdM):
