

## Italy - Lorenzo de' Medici Florence, Rome, Tuscania, Venice, 3 City Grade Conversion

Each institution has their own system for evaluating student coursework, which may include differences in the number of credit hours earned for courses. The following articulation information has been agreed upon by Illinois State University and your study abroad host institution.

**All Lorenzo de' Medici (LdM) campus grades follow the standard American system of grading.**

| LdM Grade | ISU Grade |

| 0-59      | F         |

### Credits Earned Conversion

Credits earned are the same as at ISU (i.e. 3 credit hours/course, 4 credit hours/course).

### Grade Articulation Process

Upon your program completion, an official transcript from your host institution will be sent to the Office of International Studies and Programs. Upon receipt, your transcript will be forwarded to the [Office of the Registrar](#) for evaluation. Your transcript and [Academic Planning Form](#) will be used together to determine the ISU equivalent credit, which will be entered into your ISU grade report. All grades earned during study abroad will impact your ISU cumulative GPA.
