Additional courses available for a fee: 3 credit elective course is \$860; 4 credit elective course is \$1,090; 3 credit Photography course is \$985; Students interested in enrolling in an additional 4 week Spanish Language Learning Course may do so on-site for the additional cost of \$880 per course.

****Study Abroad Non-Instructional Cost Includes:** Family Homestay for **83** nights (includes 1 day before and 1 day after official program dates) with two meals per day (breakfast and dinner), private room, weekly laundry, airport pickup and drop off (registration required), free shuttle service. **There is a \$5 per day surcharge for students with special dietary needs such as Vegan, lactose intolerant, or celiac diets.**
