****Study Abroad Non-Instructional Cost includes:**

Single occupancy housing (1 students/bedroom), typically in residential areas of Nicosia near campus; On-site orientation and emergency support from local staff; Airport pickup on designated group arrival days; Insurance for overseas medical expenses, medical evacuation and repatriation; Use of a GSM cell phone handset. Welcome & Farewell dinners.

Excursions: Seven to eight days of exciting day and overnight excursions in Cyprus and multiple cultural activities and experiences; All ground transportation for host country excursions; Double-occupancy accommodation in tourist-class hotels including breakfast during any overnight group travel; All admission fees to museums and cultural institutions visited with the group; All guide fees for group trips and excursions.

Please note that this itemized budget sheet is a per term estimate accurate at the time of publication and is subject to change. The "Estimated Independent Costs Paid Directly by the Student" section is based on estimates and it addresses basic necessities and light to moderate personal expenses. Costs can fluctuate based on changes in currency exchange rates, tuition and fees increases, varying personal lifestyles, etc.
