All ground transportation for host country excursions; Double-occupancy accommodation in tourist-class hotels including breakfast during any overnight group travel; All admission fees to museums and cultural institutions visited with the group; All guide fees for group trips and excursions; Airport welcome and transfer from Larnaca airport to Nicosia; All airport transfers when traveling with the group; Insurance for overseas medical expenses, medical evacuation and repatriation
