Instituto Franklin-UA withdrawal policy:

Upon acceptance: students will liable for a non-refundable withdrawal fee of 500 Euros (approx. \$555)

Withdrawal within first 7 days of the program: student will be charged 25% of the total cost of the program plus any additional costs incurred by Instituto Franklin-UAH on their behalf

Withdrawal within day 8 - 24 of the program: student will be charged 50% of the total of the cost of the program plus any additional costs incurred by Instituto Franklin-UAH on their behalf

Withdrawal after day 25 of the program: student will be charged 100% of the total of the cost of the program plus any additional costs incurred by Instituto Franklin-UAH on their behalf
