LdM Semester Housing Cancellation Policy:

46 days or MORE prior to the check-in date: the \$300 security deposit and \$1,200 of the rent payment will be refunded.

45-31 days preceding the check-in date: Student will lose the security deposit (\$300) but will be refunded the \$1,200 of the rent payment.

30-11 days preceding the check-in date: Student is liable for the \$300 security deposit and \$1,200 of the rent payment.

10-0 days preceding the check-in date or if student fails to check-in to their housing assignment: Student is responsible for the full rental amount of the accommodation for the entire academic term.

LDM Tuition Cancellation Policy:

45-31 days prior to the beginning of the term: Student will be liable for \$500 of tuition

30-1 days prior to the beginning of the term: Student will be liable for half of the tuition cost.

After the start of the program: No refund will be made.
