To include induction, welcome lunch, transportation and entrance with guided tour of Brighton Pavilion, theatre tickets to Theatre Royal in Brighton if available. Transportation and entrance to Bodiam Castle. Transportation and guided walking tour of London. Transportation and visit to Beachy Head and Alfriston (famous local sights). Escort and transportation to schools. Two weekend field trips, one to Bath and Stonehenge to include accommodation, transport, breakfast, entrance to Roman Baths and Stonehenge, another to Oxford and Stratford-upon-Avon to include Bed and Breakfast, theatre tickets to Royal Shakespeare Theatre, tour of Stratford-upon-Avon and entrance to Warwick Castle.
