***IFSA Program Fee Includes:** Mandatory onsite orientation program; **Transportation:** Airport pickup and drop off in Dublin by IFSA staff; Round trip transportation from Dublin to Belfast by bus; Round trip transportation for all excursions; **Housing:** Students will be housed in single occupancy rooms in a residence hall; **Activities:** Nine academic site visits to local schools; two guest lectures; Walking tour of Belfast, day trip to Causeway Coast; Day trip to Derry including local tour and museum visit. **Included Meals:** Lunch voucher on arrival day, welcome dinner, daily breakfast, group lunches on day trips to Causeway Coast and Derry, and farewell dinner.
