Optional Excursion to Florence - \$650.00 Includes roundtrip train transportation, shared hotel accommodations for students for two nights (hotel includes internet access and daily breakfast), city Tour including entrance to the Duomo and bell tower, Ponte Vecchio, Piazzale Michelangelo, Central Market, and Santa Croce with visit to Scuola del Cuoio, entrance to Uffizi Gallery, group Meal at a Florentine Restaurant.
