**Instituto Franklin-UA withdrawal policy:**

Upon acceptance: Students will liable for a non-refundable withdrawal fee of 500 Euros (approx. \$570)

Within first 7 days of program: 25% of the total program cost due plus any additional costs incurred by Instituto Franklin-UAH on their behalf

Within day 8 -14 of the program: 50% of the total program cost due plus any additional costs incurred by Instituto Franklin-UAH on their behalf

After day 15 of the program: 100% of the total program cost due plus any additional costs incurred by Instituto Franklin-UAH on their behalf
