The process of grade articulation:

At the end of your program, a transcript from your study abroad university will be sent to the Office of International Studies and Programs. Your transcript, together with your Academic Planning Form you completed as part of your application, will be evaluated. You will receive equivalent ISU grades on your transcript which will count toward your GPA.
