Grade Conversion

Each university evaluates their students slightly differently. Sometimes there are even differences in terms of credits earned. The following articulation information has been agreed upon by Illinois State University and your study abroad institution.

Grade Conversion

WIT Grade	ISU Grade
70 or above	A
50-69	B
40-49	C
39 and below	F

Credit Conversion

Students earn 5 credits per successfully completed course at WI, unless stated otherwise.

WIT Credits Earned	ISU Credits Earned
5 credits	2.5 credits

COB students will receive 1 ISU credit for each 2 ECTS earned. In some courses, this means that credits will not match exactly ISU courses. So for example, 2.5 ISU credits will be granted for 5 ECTS classes but COB will waive the 0.5 hours for COB classes requirements. However, the University will still require 120 hours of which must be 42 senior hours for graduation.

The process of grade articulation:

At the end of your program, a transcript from your study abroad university will be sent to the Office of International Studies and Programs. Your transcript, together with the Course Placement Request Sheet you completed as part of your application, will be evaluated. You will receive equivalent ISU grades on your transcript which will count toward your GPA. This process can take time. **Please be patient!** If it has been more than two months since the completion of your program and you have not received any grade information, please contact a study abroad advisor.
