\*4 Repeat credit is NOT offered in Granada, nor is it available for returning students from Granada.

\*5 Literature credit for SPA323 or SPA326 (at the Hispanic Studies Level **only**) can only be earned if the student has already taken SPA233. And Literature credit for SPA385 can only be earned if the student has already taken SPA233
